Muscles, flesh, bones, blood vessels, the human body in all of its details is tastefully explored in the large-scale, highly aesthetic drawings of the Parisian-born artist Arghaël. The Loo & Lou Gallery is presenting a host of his works in a show entitled *Métamorphe(s)*, which explores the unique techniques of this artist whose drawings, seem to be one-dimensional sculptures. He uses the mineral qualities of charcoal, oil and chalk alone or in a combination to render the human and literally the inner human on canvases of linen. These giants, sketched in largely inorganic materials, gifted with exaggerated extremities, strange faces that appear to vanish, seem at times to be in levitation. - PV.
